

## **Canada Summit Centre Protocol**

- Masks must be worn by everyone (players, bench staff, volunteers, spectators) for the entire time they are inside the Canada Summit Centre – the only exception to this is for players and on ice volunteers while on the ice (all bench staff must wear a mask while on the bench or anywhere other than the ice during practice; trainers must wear a mask when tending to a player on or off the ice)
- entry to the CSS is through the main entrance only (no one is permitted to enter through any other door); to exit the CSS, leave through the exit doors by the Don Lough lower lobby washrooms (please follow the arrows and directions while in the CSS)
- everyone must line up where indicated outside the CSS, masks and physical distancing are required while waiting to enter the facility
- the doors will be unlocked to allow entry for hockey participants and spectators for 15 minutes only, beginning 15 minutes prior to the hour – the doors will be locked on the hour (entry will not be permitted after this time) – if spectators wish to attend, they must come in during the 15 minute window, if they leave they will not be able to re-enter and must wait for their player in the parking lot
- everyone who enters the building must be checked in by the person doing the Contact Tracing
- everyone entering the building during a hockey related event must have done the COVID-19 prescreening and passed it prior to entry (can be found on our website under the COVID 19 tab)
- Managers/Team Representatives must fill in the Contact Tracing Sheet (blank copies can be found on our website under the COVID 19 tab) for their teams and their spectators – spectators can be added as a +1 next to the applicable player they are coming to watch
- once completed, Contact Tracing Sheets need to be handed into the CSS Customer Service Staff - if one is not available, please leave the sheets on the table with the plexiglass on it in the main entrance lobby
- there are two Changing Stations that alternate on the hour – Station 1 is in the Don lower lobby (with Dressing Room #10 for goalies and washroom use during

ice time) and Station 2 is next to the home bench area (with Dressing Room #12 for goalies and washroom use during ice time) – both teams on any designated hour will share the changing station – in the main entrance lobby the Changing Station schedule will be posted on a board or TV, also Customer Service Staff will know the schedule

- Spectators may help their players with equipment before and after their ice times, but are asked not to congregate in the changing area when not assisting

- all spectators are to go directly upstairs to the warm viewing area of the Don Lough Arena – stands are not open at this time and spectators are not permitted to hang out anywhere in the lower area/lobby/ice surface (to go directly to the parking lot at the conclusion of the ice time unless they are assisting their player with equipment)

- Public Washrooms are open

- Fountains are not in use – all players must bring their own (labelled) water bottle, they can fill it in the water filling station

- we are permitted one spectator per player (this must be followed to be certain we do not go over the numbers currently permitted in line with Public Health in accordance with the CSS facilities policy)
